How to make a panda bear using fondant and an Easter egg



You will need the following tools:

- A sharp knife;
- A small ball tool; and
- A small sized heart shaped cutter

You will also need the following:

- A quantity of green fondant;
- A quantity of white fondant;
- A small quantity of yellow fondant;
- Some corn flour in a bowl to prevent sticking;
- A toothpick;
- Edible glue;
- An Easter egg with an oval shape [I used a white candy coated one the size of a chicken's egg]; and
- A black edible ink marking pen

Let's start – Steps 1 and 2



Roll a ball of the white fondant for the head. Roll a small oval shape from white fondant for the muzzle and flatten it as per the picture on the left. Roll out a small piece of green fondant and cut out a small heart shape for the face. Roll a small ball of green fondant for the nose and two slightly larger halls for the ears. Use a small ball tool to shape the ears as per the picture on the left.



Use edible glue to attach the heart shaped face to the front of the head and attach the ears as per the picture on the left. Attach the muzzle with a dab of edible glue and then attach the nose.

Steps 3 and 4



Roll to tubes of green fondant for the arms. Slightly flatten one end for the shoulder and the other end for the paws.
Use the toothpick to make the definition for the paws.

Use edible glue to attach the arms to the upright Easter egg – the pointed side should be at the top of the body.



Roll two thicker tubes of green fondant for the legs. Thin the fondant to shape the legs and flatter the bottom of the remaining ball at the bottom of each leg and shape into a foot as per the picture above₅

Steps 5 and 6



Roll two small balls of white fondant, flatten and use a toothpick to make the pupils.



Roll six small balls of white fondant, flatten and attach to the feet to make the paw pads. Use a black edible ink marking pen to make the pupils.

Steps 7 and 8



Roll out a small piece of yellow fondant and cut out two small rectangles. Fold each rectangle in half, keeping the two pieces from meeting as per the pictures on the right, and pleat the other ends.

Use edible glue to stick the two pieces of the bow together. Cut out another small rectangle of yellow fondant and dab the back with edible glue. Stick down over the join and tuck the ends under.

Attach under the panda's head.
